

Architectural Standards Self-Audit

This self-audit is a tool providing each homeowner the opportunity to recognize any external modifications requiring Architectural Review Committee (ARC) approval, as well as the opportunity to address them before they could be cited. No record of the self-audit is kept by the homeowners' association or the management company, Community Partners; it is merely a mechanism for homeowner identification of potential violations. Citations could result in removal, remodeling, violation charges, and until the situation is resolved, a buyer may choose to delay the home closing. (**Note 1**, below.)

How can I effectively perform my own audit?

Each category in the self-audit has a brief description and a list of items to consider. This checklist is certainly not inclusive of every possible standard so if you have any questions about a modification or standard, please contact the site office. Walking your property outdoors is highly recommended as you accomplish the self-audit to preclude overlooking a previously completed project.

Instructions:

- 1. Category by category, place a checkmark in the "Yes" box for each applicable item.
- 2. After you complete the self-audit, review your ARC files and place a checkmark in the "ARC" box by each of the items of which you have received ARC approval.
- 3. Place a checkmark in the "No" box for any item you have not received ARC approval. It is strongly recommended you submit an ARC request for each of these items before it could be cited.
- 4. If the item was on your property when you purchased your home, place a check in the "??" box and feel free to contact the office for information. ARC records are kept with the property address throughout all re-sales.

5. Keep this audit in your files and feel free to contact the office if you have any questions.

Note 1:

The <u>Virginia Property Owners' Association Act</u> requires that a "disclosure packet" is delivered to the buyers of any home in any HOA in Virginia. Among the required contents is "a statement that any improvement or alteration made to the lot, or uses made of the lot or common area assigned to such lot, is or is not in violation of the declaration, bylaws, rules and regulations, architectural guidelines, and articles of incorporation, if any, of the association"

Accordingly, the management company conducts a presale ARC compliance inspection. Architectural changes without approval discovered during the pre-sale inspection are communicated to the seller to reconcile: provide proof of ARC approval (missing or incomplete association records) or request "after-the-fact" approval which may or may not be approved as requested on the critical timeline needed for a home sale.

1. ACCESSORY BUILDINGS - If you have any building structures other than your house, each structure is required to have ARC approval. Any changes to these structures require ARC approval as well. Check "yes" for each that applies.

4. FENCING – All fencing requires ARC approval. Please place a check in the "yes" box of applicable item.

8. PAINT – Check "yes" to any of the items below that you have been painted a different color.

9. REMODELING – Any exterior modifications to your home, need ARC approval. Check "yes" to all modifications that apply to your home:

10.REPAIRS – Check "yes" by each item that applies. ARC approval is necessary if you make repairs by replacing with a different style, different color, or in some cases, changes of material. Normal repairs with the same material/style/color typically do not require ARC approval.

11. TRASH RECEPTACLES – Other than on trash pick-up day, if you can see your trash receptacles fr the road, you are not in compliance. Check "yes" by your situation.

12. GENERAL PROPERTY CHECK – Check "yes" by each item that applies. ARC approval is NOT necessary but these items are inspected during the May annual inspection each year. The items listed are the most common issues.
Yes ARC No ?? Power wash house to remove mold/mildew/stains Gutter cleaning to remove leaves/debris Lawn care/excessive weeds in yard Improper storage (things left in driveway or front yards)
