



On behalf of the Board of Directors and the Pool Committee, I would like to welcome you to the 2026 Pool Season. This season, the Pool will be managed by Coastline Aquatics once again. We have a strong relationship with the leadership of the company and expect to continue to work with them to have a successful season. As with every year, the lifeguards will be a mix of both Milestone Residents and non-residents. We are happy that several of our neighborhood children who grew up at the pool are taking the opportunity to take on the responsibility of being a lifeguard at the pool. We ask that all people attending the pool be respectful of the guards and support them in their efforts to keep the pool operating in a safe manner.

We have not made significant changes to the pool rules for this season. Please understand that the rules are not in place to spoil anyone's enjoyment of the pool. They are necessary to provide a safe and welcoming environment for everyone who uses the pool. Please be mindful that GLASS containers of any kind are not permitted on the pool deck (i.e., bottles, drinking glasses, glass food containers). GLASS breaking on the pool deck is a serious safety issue that may result in the pool needing to be completely drained, cleaned, and refilled.

We will again be limiting the use of floats in the pool. The guards need to have a clear view of the bottom of the pool, and large opaque floats block their view. They can also infringe on the use of the pool by others.

This year, we are going to try to have a 10-minute lap swim/walk break at the end of each hour. During this period, the only swimming allowed will be lap swimming in the lanes. The diving well, diving board, and the shallow end of the pool will be closed. Any activity in the middle lanes of the pool that prevents lap swimming will be a violation of the rules. This time is meant for patrons of the pool who want to be able to use the lap lanes for exercise.

This season, we will be communicating via mass email to send out notices of any pool closings and other messages. We will continue to utilize Member Splash as well. If you have an existing account, you will need to upload new photos for each member.

Please feel free to reach out to the Pool committee (pool@milestonecommunity.com) with any questions and suggestions. We will have a QR code posted at the lifeguard stand to quickly access this email. I would like to thank the members of that committee for their time and dedication to the continuous improvement of Milestone's pool. This year, Coastline Aquatics will have completed our pool's new tiling & resurfacing.
