Spring is here and summer vacations are just around the corner. Do you feel your home and property are secure from theft? Would you feel more secure knowing your property is checked daily by a sheriff's deputy while on vacation?

Here are two opportunities for homeowners to take advantage of free programs offered by the Hanover County Sheriff's department:

1. A Hanover Deputy will conduct a security evaluation of your house and property. They will review inside and outside of the home and the property. A report with the findings and recommendations will be delivered to the homeowners.
2. Another service offered by the Hanover Sheriff's office provides a daily drive by of your property while away. This service provides a least one per day drive by, but depending on how busy a day is, there are possibilities for multiple drive by's. Anything out of the normal, like a car in the driveway or someone on the property, the deputy will place a call to the number left when the service was requested.

Just place a call to the **non-emergency** number, (804) 365-6140 to request either of these free services.

Look for more programs hosted by the Hanover Sheriff's Department at www.hanoversheriff.com to be announced in the coming months.

DO YOU WANT TO GET INVOLVED?? We are always looking to get more people trained in our trained position jobs. These jobs include strokes and turns, clerk of course, starter or being a table worker. Swim meets run on volunteer power and cannot be completed without these trained positions. Over the next two seasons we will be losing 3 of our vital board members who help with too many things to put in this newsletter. REGISTRATION INFO: Registration for swim team opens 4/1. You will be able to register on our website. <https://milestonemakos.swimtopia.com/>. Dates for the season have all been updated on the website. We invite all families who are members of the Milestone pool with children aged 5-18 to considering joining swim team. If your child can't quite make it across the pool yet we will have a Junior Team. Please note the swim team is not a substitute for swim lessons. Your child should know how to swim before joining Makos swim team. I recommend our younger swimmers to take formal swim lessons before joining Milestone Makos. Burkwood, Patrick Henry YMCA and American Family Fitness all offer swim lessons regularly if you are looking to squeeze in a session before the Makos season starts. For our seasoned swimmers, Burkwood offers a program in the spring to get you swimmer ready for summer swim. Please go to their website if you are interested in more information.

JUNIOR TEAM: At the youngest, your child should be a rising 1st grader by June 2026 (in kindergarten the 25/26 school year). Your swimmer should be able to swim, this is not a substitute for swim lessons!! This team is just for the child who may not be able to swim the full 25 meters across the pool, however they should be able to swim at least ½ of that. Once your child can swim a full 25 meters, they can move mid-season to join the Makos swim team and participate in a swim meet.

Key Duties for Pool Operations

The Committee Chair oversees community pool operations and acts as main contact for the HOA board, site manager, and pool management company.

Main Contact

The Chair regularly checks pool email and responds quickly, keeping communication open and resolving issues swiftly.

Committee Leadership

Organizes monthly pool committee meetings and attends all HOA board meetings to provide pool updates.

Pool Furniture

Tracks pool furniture and notifies the HOA board and management company when items need repair or replacement.

Member Splash & Communications

Works with the site manager to run reports, update Member Splash, and keep members informed about hours, closures, and events.

Pool Rules

Collaborates with the pool committee to update rules each season.

Contract Management

Reviews pool contracts annually with the HOA board to ensure all terms are met.

Lifeguard Training

Coordinates lifeguard training with the HOA site manager on Member Splash.

Conclusion

The Committee Chair ensures smooth pool operations, clear communication, and well-maintained facilities.

ANNUAL COMPLIANCE INSPECTION

Overview

The Homeowners Association (HOA) carries out an annual inspection of the entire community to ensure compliance with established standards. The Board of Directors encourages all homeowners to take this opportunity to review their properties and address any maintenance issues or perform a thorough spring cleaning. Below are some of the most common items found to be in violation of Milestone standards:

Common Compliance Issues

Mailboxes: Check for rotted wood, ensure painting and cleaning are up to date, and verify that mailbox numbers are compliant with community guidelines.

Shutters: Replace any missing shutters and refresh those with faded colors.

HVAC/Trash Bins/Generator Screening: Ensure that any required screening is at least as tall as the current equipment to properly conceal it.

Window AC Units: These are prohibited on the front of houses. If window AC units are to be installed on the sides of houses, prior approval is required.

Siding: Siding should be power-washed as needed to maintain a clean appearance.

Gutters: Remove leaves and debris from gutters to prevent blockages and potential water damage.

Lawn & Shrubs: Keep lawns mowed, shrubs trimmed, and weeds under control to ensure proper maintenance.

Trash Cans: Trash cans must not be visible from the street.

Boats/Trailers/RVs: These vehicles should not be parked in driveways or roadways.

Architectural Modifications

Remember that ALL MODIFICATIONS to the exterior of your home/property must receive prior approval from the Architectural Review Committee before making the modification. Regular inspections of rear yards are not performed; however, when a home is sold, a resale inspection will take place to verify that all exterior modifications received proper approval. Unapproved additions—including sheds, fences, patios, playsets, or other structures—will be disclosed to the buyer and may complicate the sale of your home. Please take the time to confirm that all your modifications have been approved.
